

“My Neighbour Card”

What is an easy way to keep your neighbourhood safe? Get to know your neighbours!

The “My Neighbour Card” is a tool for building neighbourly relationships.

Front of the card:

- Asks simple questions about your neighbourhood
- If you don’t know the answers, flip over your card

Back of the card:

- Has fill-in-the-blanks for names, address and phone numbers of 8 homes surrounding your home

What to do:

- Print this card (double sided is best)
- Print some off for your neighbours to give to them when you ask for their information!
- Take the card around to meet your neighbours (or catch up!) and fill it out
